Dear Madam Inspector General:

During this year's general election, numerous allegations of fraud have been made, and unfortunately some pertain to operations within the U.S. Postal Service (USPS), which include allegations of discarding mail-in ballots, backdating mail ballots and withholding the processing of one side's campaign mail.

First, a recent audio recording emerged on the internet of an interview between two federal postal agents and a postal employee whistleblower from Erie, Pennsylvania who alleged mail-in ballots were removed from the regular mail stream and possibly backdated.¹ Is this matter still under investigation?

Second, at a press conference this week a truck driver who subcontracts for the postal service claimed to have hauled hundreds of thousands of completed ballots from Bethpage, New York across state lines to Lancaster, Pennsylvania where his trailer later mysteriously disappeared from a USPS depot.² At the same event, yet another whistleblower, a postal service subcontractor from Wisconsin, has spoken publicly about a plan with the USPS to backdate late arriving ballots.³

Third, a witness recently signed an affidavit in a Michigan lawsuit witnessing large bags- thought to contain ballots- suspiciously dropped behind a local post office for a waiting USPS mail truck.⁴ The witness supplied pictures of these suspicious bags. A similar account was offered by another Michigan witness alleging mass ballot drops at a different postal facility and supplied more detailed pictures to the Michigan State Legislature.

Finally, news reports from Nevada claim that the USPS is actively preventing its employees with knowledge of election fraud from coming forward and telling their accounts in a court of law.⁵ Everyday new allegations of fraud are coming to light which present a pattern of widespread election fraud. If the Postal Service or its employees have information that is relevant to fraud allegations that could impact election results, the public has a right to hear it in a timely manner to ensure the integrity of their votes.

A constituent of Florida's Eighth Congressional District raised valid questions concerning the USPS. Does the USPS offer rewards to postal employees to report any suspicious behavior concerning backdating voting ballots and other actions that undermine election integrity? Do USPS facilities have tapes from video surveillance systems that can be reviewed? Do USPS vehicles and trucks have GPS devices that can be helpful as part of an investigation, and if so, have you investigated to determine which vehicles may have been at the drop locations raised by eyewitnesses?

I urge you to investigate any and all potential irregularity or fraud that may contribute to the public's perception of the process and confidence in the outcome. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
