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NARRATIVE

Section 1: Narrative

On Sunday, February 4th, 2024, at approximately 1328 hours, Deputy Rivera (ID 4714) responded to 6091 Stadium Parkway, Melbourne, Brevard County, Florida 32940, In reference to an alleged sex offender working at the Strawberry Festival (CR# 24-41019).

I was contacted by Deputy Rivera regarding a sexual offender known as Mr. Charles Maslin. I was advised Mr. Maslin was currently at the above location during the Strawberry Festival, due to him owning and operating two food trucks. Deputy Rivera advised Mr. Maslin stated he was working the food trucks he owned and was staying at the La Quinta Inn, located at 7200 George T. Edwards Drive, Melbourne. I was further advised Mr. Maslin stated to Deputy Rivera he had only been in Florida since February 1st, 2024. I was also advised by Deputy Rivera that Mr. Maslin's employees also confirmed he arrived in Florida on February 1st, 2024.

I conducted a search of Mr. Maslin's information via the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) Sexual Offender and Predator System (SOPS), in which I observed Mr. Maslin was convicted of a sexual offense third degree in Maryland on October 07, 1999, court number 12K96001002. Due to Mr. Maslin's conviction, FDLE determined Mr. Maslin is required to register as a sexual offender in the state of Florida. I further observed Mr. Maslin's permanent address to be 100 South Washington Street, Havre De Grace, Maryland, 21078.

Based on the information provided by Deputy Rivera, I was unable to establish probable cause for Mr. Maslin's arrest for violation of the 1,000-foot county ordinance based on the county ordinance having an exception for when a sexual offender or predator is gainfully employed.

At this time, I was also unable to establish probable cause for Mr. Maslin's arrest for failure to register as a sexual offender in Florida based on the fact of him only being in Brevard County for three days at the time I was contacted by Deputy Rivera.

On Tuesday, February 6, 2024, I responded to the La Quinta Inn, located at 7200 George T. Edwards Drive, Melbourne, to inquire if Mr. Maslin had a room. I made contact with Ms. Martha Harris (Involved Person), who stated the following in substance during a sworn recorded statement: She advised Mr. Maslin was staying at the hotel because she had interactions with him during his stay. She advised Mr. Maslin would make several complaints as well as say good morning to her every day. She advised she first noticed Mr. Maslin at the hotel around January 24th or 25th, however, she was not sure about the date. Ms. Harris did provide me with a receipt for room 219, in

which the name for the room was Charles Maslin and began on January 19, 2024, and ended February 4, 2024. Ms. Harris further advised Mr. Maslin left on February 5, 2024.

Due to Ms. Harris's statement, I requested for a photographic line up, in which Agent M. Melione (ID 4123) conducted the photographic line up. Upon completion of the photographic line up. Agent Melione advised me of the outcome, in which Ms. Harris identified Mr. Maslin's photograph (referred to Agent Melione's supplement report).

It should be noted, based on the information provided by Ms. Harris and her positively identifying Mr. Maslin being at the hotel, Mr. Maslin was potentially in Brevard County from the dates of January 24 or 25 until February 5, 2024.

While writing an arrest warrant affidavit for Mr. Maslin, I observed Deputy Rivera stated in his report Mr. Maslin provided proof of an "AMTRAK" train ticket he purchased from Washington D.C. to Florida. I then contacted Deputy Rivera, in which he had taken a photograph of the "AMTRAK" train ticket. I observed in the photograph the ticket was purchased for \$150.00 and the transaction date was Sunday, January 28, 2024, however, it does not show a departure date or time.

It should be noted, based on the information provided by Ms. Harris and her positively identifying Mr. Maslin being at the hotel, Mr. Maslin was potentially in Brevard County from the dates of January 24 or 25 until February 5, 2024.

At this time, based on the totality of circumstances, I am unable to establish probable cause for Mr. Maslin's failure to register a temporary address in Brevard County, Florida, due to him having a confirmation purchased "AMTRAK" train ticket, which conflicts with Ms. Harris's statement.

Section 2: Crime Scene

The crime scene consisted of 6091 Stadium Parkway, Melbourne, Florida, 32940.

A business certification form and a property receipt were filled out for the La Quinta Registration and Receipt they provided.

Utilizing my department issued iPhone, I conducted a sworn recorded statement with Ms. Harris, which was uploaded to a digital media file (BCSO CIS Digital Evidence).
