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**SUPPLEMENTAL NARRATIVE**

On May 20, 2025, I (Detective Harrison #3576), was assigned follow-up investigation in reference to a disturbance resulting in a battery which occurred at Ichabod's Dockside Bar and Grille, located at 2210 Front Street, Melbourne, Florida, on May 6, 2024 (case number 2025-00104366).

As a precursor to this follow-up, I was originally assigned to investigate the death of Mark Senti, which occurred at the Melbourne Harbor Marina located at 2210 Front Street, on January 11, 2025. This case was investigated under case number 2025-00003009. At the time, Senti's body had been found floating in the water next to his vessel which was tied to a dock. During the death investigation, I learned Senti was a party to the aforementioned disturbance on May 6, 2024, and may have incurred an injury as a result. Pursuant to the autopsy performed by the Brevard County Medical Examiner's Office, the cause of Senti's death was determined to be 'Drowning,' and the manner of death listed as 'Undetermined.' Notated in her findings, Dr. Schmidt (MEO) could not rule out traumatic seizure disorder as a contributing factor.

On May 20, 2025, I requested subpoenas for Holmes Regional Medical Center, Dr. Ahmad Abukhamis, and Dr. Joran Loftis, to obtain all medical records on Senti. As the next of kin, Wade Senti (Mark's eldest son) signed Medical Release forms authorizing Melbourne Police Department to obtain the information.

Also during the investigation, I reviewed all Body-Worn Camera video and in-car camera video regarding the investigation conducted on May 6, 2024. The summary of my findings are as follows:

At 2006 hours, Officer Smith #5047 turned his body-worn camera on as he arrived on scene. At 2008 hours, Senti was offered Medical Assistance by Officer Smith and declined. At 2010 hours, Senti is speaking with Officer Smith and states "saw this stuff going on, I walked over to them to break it up". Also at 2010 hours, Senti is asked if he wished to pursue criminal charges against the suspect(s), to which he verbally declines. At 2027 hours, Senti signed a decline-to-prosecute affidavit for the charge of Battery.

At 2006 hours, Officer Hamilton #5027 turned on his Body-Worn Camera as he arrived on scene. At 2006 hours, Officer Hamilton was provided the suspects' description of "two white males, stocky build". At 2011 hours, Officer Hamilton was provided the names from the credit card receipt of the suspects from the bartender (unknown name). At 2017 hours, Officer Hamilton makes contact with an employee who produces surveillance video of the incident. At 2026 hours, Officer Hamilton obtains a sworn video statement from Thora Snow, who was an

employee of Ichabod's and also a victim of a battery during this incident.

At 2008 hours, Officers Alabise, Murphy, McKinney, Iervasi and Goetsch made contact with both Gavin and Warrick Smith on US1 just south of New Haven Avenue. Officers placed the subjects in two different police vehicles. Ultimately, based on the information officers obtained as a result of their investigation on the evening of May 6, 2024, Gavin Smith was placed under arrest for Battery, and Warrick Smith was trespassed from Ichabod's Dockside Bar and Grille.

On May 7, 2024, Officers Worniak and Fahy responded to Holmes Regional Medical Center (HRMC) located at 1350 Hickory Street, Melbourne, Florida, around 1658 hours and made contact with Senti. Senti had been transported from Palm Bay Hospital to HRMC as a Trauma Alert. After Senti gave permission to the nurse in the room (unknown name) to advise of his medical condition. At 1702 hours, the nurse advised that during transport, Senti had suffered a seizure in the ambulance. She advised during their testing and evaluation/treatment at HRMC, they assessed that Senti suffered from a brain bleed although he had no other visible injuries or abrasions. Senti told the officers the suspect who attacked him was in an orange shirt which would have been Warrick Smith. At 1703 hours, Senti advised he wished to pursue criminal charges for Battery, and subsequently signed an affidavit at 1704 hours. Officer Worniak sent an email to Officer Hamilton on May 7, 2024 advising Senti's wishes to pursue criminal charges.

On May 13, 2024, Officer Hamilton completed a capias request for Battery on Warrick Smith. Additional charges were also sent to the Brevard County Jail for Gavin Smith, however, these charges were not for Senti being the victim, but rather for Caitlyn Walker and Nicholas George.

The week of May 19, 2025, I reviewed the video from inside the restaurant on the night of the incident. At the southeast corner of the bar, from left to right, I observed Gavin Smith (Blue Shirt), Warrick Smith (Orange Shirt), Kathleen Pollard, Ronald Pollard and another unknown female subject. On the video you can see all five parties speaking. Gavin proceeds to stand up and walk towards Ronald, Ronald also stands up as Gavin approaches. Both males engage in a physical altercation, grabbing and striking one another, while Kathleen tries to separate them. Another unidentified female is observed coming into the frame from the north to stop the altercation.

At this point, I observed seven other males walk into the frame from off camera to include Senti from the north side of the bar. Thora (employee of Ichabod's) is observed coming into frame and telling Gavin to leave. Thora is able to guide Gavin to the exit door toward the docks. Thora was standing at the door with Gavin while Warrick was walking toward them, now only in what

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appeared to be a verbal confrontation. Senti approached Warrick from the backside and placed his right hand on Warrick's left arm. Warrick turned around and open hand strike Senti in the face/nose with his left hand. Gavin re-engages and punches Mark with his right fist on the left side of Mark's face. Mark falls to the floor from the punch to the face and is not seen again until police arrival several minutes later.

Based on this video, both Gavin Smith and Warrick Smith committed the criminal violation of Battery against the Pollard's, Snow, and Nicholas George. A criminal history inquiry revealed no history for Warrick Smith. A similar inquiry found that Gavin had no prior convictions for Battery prior to May 6, 2024. Based on this information, I assessed that the appropriate charge for both Gavin and Warrick on May 6, 2024 was Battery, Florida State Statute 784.03.

On May 22, 2025, Mark Senti's next of kin and eldest son, Wade Senti, provided me with the following possible witness names and contact information:

Ronald Pollard, Kathy Pollard, Nicholas George, Thora Snow, Terrence Clowney, and Gail Fischer.

Of this list of people, I was only able to successfully make contact with Nicolas George. George stated he was present the evening of the incident, however advised he never witnessed Senti get struck by Gavin or Warrick. Nicholas provided a sworn audio statement which was uploaded to evidence.com. Several attempts to reach the other witnesses yield negative results.

On May 29, 2025, I received an email from Dr. Loftis' Office advising Senti was never a patient with him or his office. Senti had attempted to see Dr. Loftis, however, they did not accept his health insurance at the time.

On June 6, 2025, I received subpoenaed medical records from Knight Neurology. The records indicated Senti had only one visit with Dr. Ahmad Abokhamis on October 31, 2024. This one visit was to regulate the medication "Keppra" Mark was taking. Keppra is an anti-epileptic medication used to treat various types of seizures. No allegations or documentation of additional seizures are listed. This document is with the case packet.

On July 11, 2025, a second subpoena request to Holmes Regional Medical Center was sent.

On July 15, 2025, Wade Senti's attorney sent me an email with additional doctors Senti visited. A subpoena request was sent to Sunrise Facial and Oral Surgery. On July 22, 2025 the subpoenaed medical records were received. The records indicated on June 5, 2024, Senti visited the office in reference to "left jaw pain and bite relationship change since accident one

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month ago". Dr. Kim's plan stated an "Intermaxillary fixation" (a techniques used to stabilize the upper and lower jaws) and his jaw would be wired shut for 8 weeks. On June 6, 2025, Senti completed the procedure with no complications.

On June 20, 2025, Senti returned to Doctor Kim's office to have the wires removed and rubber bands placed in. No complications listed during this visit. July 25, 2025, Senti returned to the office in reference to swelling and pain. Notes list there were no complications and Senti would have the wire removed in two weeks. On August 14, 2025, Senti had the hardware removed and was sent home with a care plan. The subpoenaed documents are included in the case packet.

On August 5, 2025, I received over 800 documents referring to Senti's visits with Holmes Regional Medical center. In reference to the May 6, 2024 incident, doctors notate Senti's complete of jaw pain and refer him to a dentist. The doctors also document the seizure Senti has. No other injuries are documented during this visit. These documents are uploaded with the case packet.

A summary of my investigative findings is as follows: After the initial physical altercation had concluded and Gavin and Warrick were being directed/guided toward an exit by staff member(s), Senti and a group of at least five other subjects approached Gavin and Warrick. Although it is possible Senti's and the group's intention by approaching the situation were to act as Good Samaritans or assist in restoring order to the situation in some manner, it is apparent that the second altercation did not occur until Senti placed his hand on Warrick Smith. As a result, in consideration of the facts, circumstances and evidence regarding the May 6, 2024 case, I do not find probable cause to charge either Gavin or Warrick Smith with battery. This case is closed.

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
